Proofreader's Remarks – Angela Isbister

It is always a pleasure proof-reading Cliff's books, because I know I am going to learn something and **Today with Ezekiel** was no exception. I learned so much more about Ezekiel, formerly a priest in the temple at Jerusalem who was willing to adapt and persevere in an alien land, although facing great opposition and difficulties.

I begin by reading through the entire manuscript, to get an understanding of the subject and how the book flows, noting any glaring mistakes, omissions and typos on the way. Then I go through a second time thoroughly scrutinising every sentence to detect any repetition or contradiction as well as any spelling, grammar or punctuation queries. Then I go through a third time to check the accuracy of the biblical quotations and references.

I really enjoy the way Cliff brings the life and times of Ezekiel so alive, we can imagine him singing and leading the housegroups and being totally overwhelmed with the visions from God that he was receiving. Cliff's easy style of writing helps us understand the problems Ezekiel was facing, with a generation growing up indifferent and ignorant of the ways of God, preferring the lifestyle of the Babylonians.

The discipline required for proof-reading really helps one to grasp in depth what is being portrayed in a book and I am now convinced that the book of Ezekiel is certainly a book for our own times. He sets an example of how to adapt and go forward to prepare for the future in the face of immense difficulties.
